Jack Gardner died in November 1992. He had a prolific life throughout Somerset County. He grew up in North Plainfield, where he was an outstanding athlete in Football, Basketball and Baseball. Jack was a detective in the Somerset County Prosecutors Office for many years. Later he became Warden of the Somerset County Jail. He was a member of the Somerville Elks Lodge #1068. He became an assistant football coach at Immaculata High School were he coached for twelve years until his passing.

Jack was a treasure. His main virtue was his willingness to help people. Anyone who came to Jack for help was assured that he would come through. Throughout Somerset County he is noted for helping many people, especially the younger generation. He was kind, thoughtful and always gave of himself.

That is why the "Jack Gardner Memorial Softball Tournament" is rightfully named. All of the tournament proceeds help those kids in need.

I wanted to share a few facts about last year's tournament, year 30...


We had 45 softball teams compete. Men's, Women's, and Co-Ed teams. We played in 6 different towns, used 9 different locations, and 19 fields all in Somerset County. Bedminster Township, Bernards Township, Bridgewater Township, Hillsborough Township, Manville Borough, and Somerville Borough. 86 Softball games were played, 186 softballs were used, food was donated from over 40 different locations, 99 tricky tray baskets won, over 50 volunteers the day of, one winner of \$10,000, over 1,000 photos taken, countless hours over the last 12 months planning and we all do this for the 52 families and kids we commonly call Jack's Kids!

Thank you all for coming out and supporting Jack's Kids. Please stay safe.


