



We recognize Ben Falcone as the July 13, 2024, Jack's Kid Rockstar for his inspiring fight and resilience. Ben's journey is one of tremendous courage and determination, marked by his battle against multiple severe health challenges. Alongside this recognition, we honor his Mom- Carrie, Dad- John, and older brother- Jack, whose dedication and love have been vital in supporting Ben through his trials.

Ben was born on May 13, 2012, and began experiencing significant health issues just three months later, including frequent hospitalizations due to monthly fevers. At 11 months old, he was diagnosed with Failure to Thrive due to an airway defect. By 22 months, Ben was diagnosed with Periodic Fever Syndrome, which brought immense physical and emotional strain to him and his family. The family faced financial difficulties and job changes while caring for Ben.

In 2016, high fevers led to a diagnosis of brain dysfunction. Over the years, Ben has also been diagnosed with Tourette's syndrome, Behçet's syndrome, and, most recently, a pituitary tumor, which has impacted his growth. Despite severe pain, multiple medical procedures, and frequent hospital visits, Ben's spirit remains unbroken.

Ben's resilience in the face of adversity is inspiring. His family's unwavering support has been a pillar throughout these trials, and they continue to fight alongside him every day.

We stand with Ben, a true Rockstar, and celebrate his remarkable journey.
